**PURPOSE:** A dual major in Middle Level Social Studies and History is meant to prepare students for a career as a highly qualified teacher education candidate skilled to teach any core subject at the 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade level and skilled to teach the Social Studies content area in the 7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade level. For state certification, students must meet all the competency standards set by The Pennsylvania Department of Education. In addition to the required courses for Middle Level Social Studies certification, students can complete nine more credits to receive a dual major with History. Students may then elect to pursue secondary teaching certification (7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade) in History.

**REQUIREMENTS:** To successfully complete a dual major with History and Middle Level Social Studies Certification, the following coursework is required:

- 48 credits as listed under "Major Component/Requirements"
- 47 credits as listed under Education Requirements (22 of which require Official Major Status prior to registration)
- 40 CORE credits
- A minimum number of 135 credits are required for degree, the last 30 of which, and 50% of the major must be earned at La Roche College. (Developmental course work does not count toward the minimum number of required credits for graduation.)
