REQUIREMENTS: To successfully complete the Pre K-4/ Dual Certification major, the following coursework is required:

- 15 credits as listed under "Major Component/Requirements"
- 79 credits of Education Requirements (45 of which require Official Major Status prior to registration)
- 40 CORE credits
- A minimum number of 134 credits are required for degree, the last 30 of which, and 50% of the major must be earned at La Roche College. (Developmental course work does not count toward the minimum number of required credits for graduation.)
