PURPOSE: Minors are offered as opportunities for students to fulfill career or personal interests, and/or to facilitate in depth study in a field of secondary interest.

GENERAL RESTRICTIONS: Minors must be completed within the student's graduation timeline. Students may not major and minor in the same department (Example: Child and Family Studies majors may not declare a psychology minor). **At least one of the psychology electives must be an upper division course (3000 or 4000 level).**

AVAILABILITY: Required coursework available during the day and evening; two academic years estimated for minor completion (Course rotation and prerequisites). Evening rotation may take longer. (NOTE: Estimate assumes student completion of zero minor credits at time of minor declaration.)
